The British Poetry Revival was a modernist-inspired poetry movement in Britain during the 1960s and 70s. Embracing a wide, and often radical, variety of approaches revivalists looked back to poets like David Jones and Hugh MacDiarmid, as well as across the Atlantic to the Beats and the New American Poetry. This reading celebrates the presence of the Revival in Wales with readings by three poets (Chris Torrance, Peter Finch, and John Freeman) associated with this movement, as well as a reading by the younger Welsh poet Kate North.
